Week of Feb. 5-16: Run your site competition and grades K-4 and 5 and up

- use 3.5 x 3.5 inch square of paper
- Full colored preferred
- Original hand drawn or digitally developed acceptable
- **The mission patch should include the words iLEAD, DreamUp and (Mission) 2018 (not the child's or school's name)**

Week of Feb 19: Choose your top two winning patches that represent your site and will be move to the finalist category **but do not announce until the Mar 2 event**

- **it is up to each site to decide how your top winning patches will be chosen**
 - ◆ Example: grade levels choosing their 3 best and submitting those for the final site competition judges
 - ◆ create a panel of learners and community members
 - ◆ consider creating a rubric
- each site must keep track of the number of learners who participated

Due Feb 26 Create a display board

- **Display should include site logo and name of site**
 - **Name of artwork, grade level and name of artist**
- Send a PDF or jpeg of your top two patches to Sara
- **Fill in and also send the participation info sheet, completed**
